On that day, Honourable Minister for Tourism, Shri Prahald Singh Patel and the Local Government announced the opening of IISM Kargil center at Naktul. Trophies, Medals and Prizes were given to the winners and Participants. Prizes included Ice Hockey sticks, Skate bags and Rucksacks, which have a functional utility and were well appreciated by the players and coaches. Besides this the team IITTM also Promoted Tourism Education Programs, IITFC program and conducted Sap activities at Kargil.
